




In praxis

Switching from the M.Zuiko 60mm macro to the Brightin Star almost doubles the weight of your setup immediately and it feels front heavy.

Mounted on my OM-D E-M1 Mk II I wished I had brought my battery grip with me to balance out the setup and have a better hold.

The f-stop markings on the lens barrel seem to be fairly linear as you can see on following test photos. To rate the Brightin Star in terms of DOF, sharpness and linearity I compared it against the M.Zuiko 60mm Macro 2.8 at a magnification of 1:1. Please judge for yourself.
